BRAZILIAN ELLIOTTIS PINE		18.00	27.00	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Used in construction • Has large live knots • Surface is filled and sanded • Ideal for cheaper hoarding • Lends itself well to painting • Has a tendency to twist 				
FINNISH SPRUCE		22.00	32.00	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An ideal constructional plywood • Relatively strong and light in weight • The surface veneer has small knot holes • Requires painting or treating if used externally 				
BRAZILIAN HARDWOOD		24.00	35.00	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quite a soft hardwood • Light in weight with an unblemished surface • Paints well • Mainly used internally but equally effective for superior hoarding • Must be painted for outside use 				
FAR EASTERN	TOP QUALITY "KRAKATAU"	14.00	30.00	40.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identical to marine plywood in appearance and finish although true marine plywood has a different internal structure • A very hard, durable and heavy plywood • Made from a dense hardwood • The surface is unblemished • Can be painted, but needs a good primer to seal beforehand
